 - (a) in any M.U.,
 - (i) a **bobcat**,
 - (ii) a **lynx**,
 - (iii) a wolverine, or
 - (b) in Region 1, 2, 4, or 8 a **wolf**,
 - (c) in Region 1 an **elk**
